Learning outcomes	The course is aimed providing key concepts and basic tools of economics needed for understanding how economic systems work.
Course contents	The course will provide basic principles of microeconomics, including: consumer choices; decisions production and costs of production; demand and supply curves and market equilibrium; competitive markets; monopolistic competition; monopoly and oligopoly; employment and pricing of inputs
Teaching methods	The course offers ex-cathedra lectures, tutoring and other teaching

activities aimed to prepare and successfully pass the exam.
