Learning outcomes	The course will address the current issues of bioethics that have developed as a result of recent advances in medicine. In particular, these topics will be considered: end of life, biological will, transplants, management of the vigilant coma, artificial fertilization, human reproduction, animal rights and climate change. In the course emphasis will be given to a continuous comparison with prejudices, uncritical beliefs and fideistic intellectual automatisms that characterize the common perception of contemporary medicine, with regard to bioethics, not so infrequently even among healthcare professionals.
