Learning outcomes	<p>The aim of this course is to critically examine the linkages between poverty, inequality and growth, the most relevant measurement issues related to inequality and poverty analysis and their implication in terms of economic and human development policies. The course is divided into two teaching modules (inequality analysis and poverty analysis) and integrated by workshops providing the skills required for carrying out empirical analysis using Stata.</p>
