Course contents	<p>Survival, transmission and reception of ancient epigraphies and palaeographical features. Categories: holy, honorific, burial, epigraphs on public buildings, of a juridical nature, and instrumentum inscriptum. Epigraphical databases. Study of selected examples. An autoptical survey of the University of Pavia's epigraphical collection will take place at the end of the course.</p>
