A thorough comprehension of all aspects of epigraphies (historical and palaeographical ones) will be achieved during the course, thanks to guided transcriptions and the analysis of selected examples. **Course contents** Survival, transmission and reception of ancient epigraphies and palaeographical features. Categories: holy, honorific, burial, epigraphs on public buildings, of a juridical nature, and instrumentum inscriptum. Epigraphical databases. Study of selected examples. An autoptical survey of the University of Pavia's epigraphical collection will take place at the end of the course. **Teaching methods** Lectures, with students' active contribution too, seminars and tutorials, workshops Reccomended or required 1) Notes about an anthology of inscriptions examined during lectures readings 2) One of the following handbooks: L.
