Learning outcomes	<p>Reading, dating, recording a latin inscription and publishing criteria of text will be taught during the lessons.</p> <p>A whole comprehension of every aspect shown by epigraphies (historical and palaeographical ones) will be achieved during the course, thanks to guided transcriptions and analysis of selected examples.</p>
Course contents	<p>Survival, transmission and reception of ancient epigraphies, palaeographical features. Categories: holy, honorific, burial, related to public buildings, juridical ones and instrumentum inscriptum.</p> <p>Epigraphical databases. Study of selected examples.</p> <p>An autoptical survey of University of Pavia's epigraphical collection will take place at the end of the course.</p>
