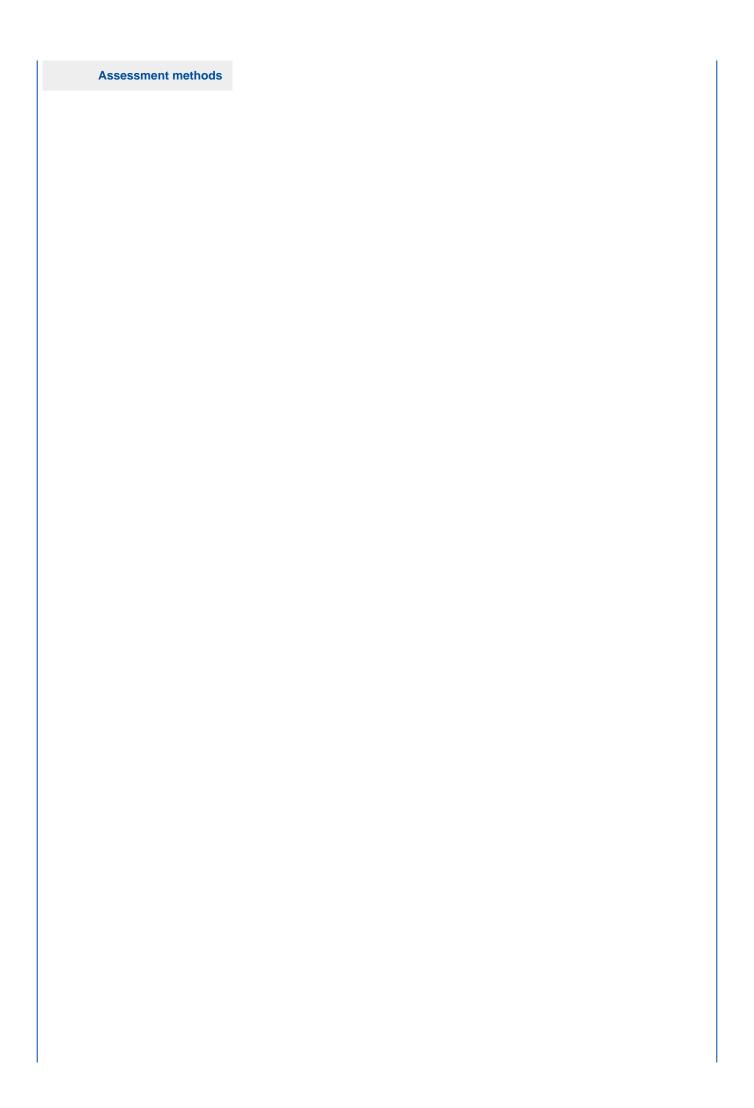

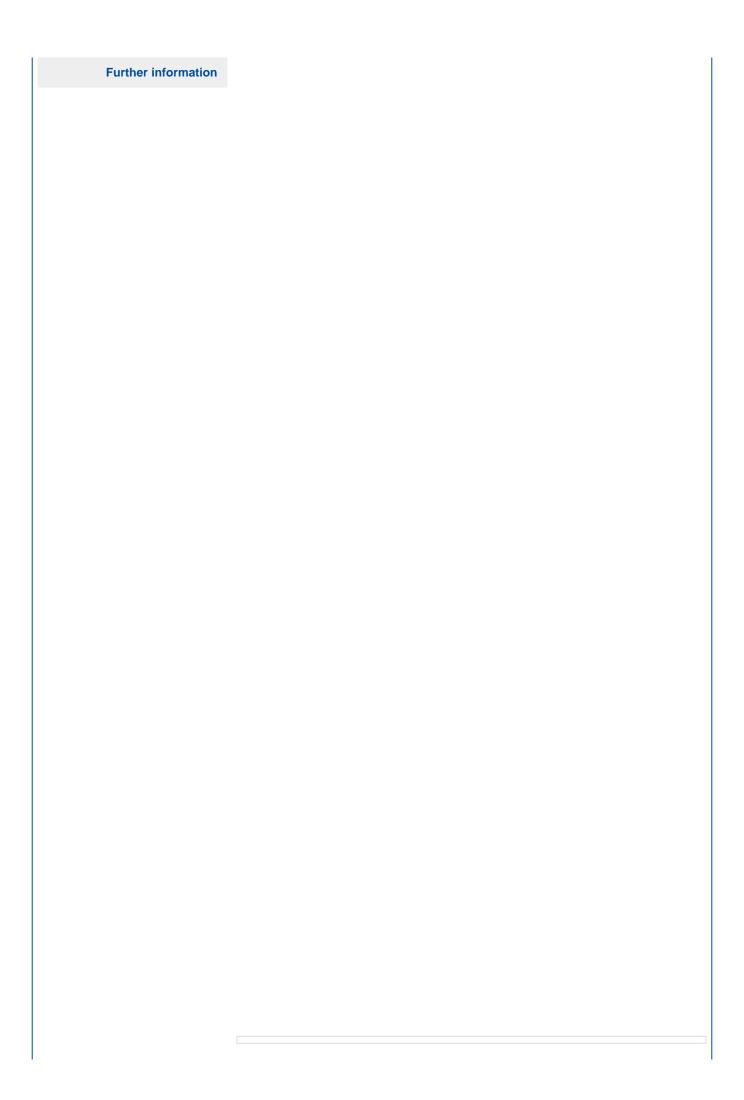


For students of philosophy of the new order (DM 270), the examination consist in a written test.
