Learning outcomes	<p>Students will reach the pre-intermediate A2/B1 communicative language competences, according to the JF standard for the Japanese Language Education.</p> <p>Students can understand the main points of clear standard input on familiar matters regularly encountered in work, school, leisure, etc.; can deal with most situations likely to arise whilst travelling in an area where the language is spoken; can produce simple connected text on topics, which are familiar, or of personal interest; can describe experiences and events, dreams, hopes & ambitions and briefly give reasons and explanations for opinions and plans.</p>
Course contents	New kanji will be introduced. Students will learn how to decline an invitation or cancel an appointment and give reason; talk about the

	<p>place where you live; talk about what you think of foreign food and your eating habits; talk about your experience and memories of living overseas; talk about how to learn a foreign language. Students will also read simple article from Japanese newspapers.</p>
