Course contents	Reading, translation and linguistic commentary, entrusted to individual study, of two Latin texts: a) Cicero, De amicitia or De senectute; b) Virgil, Aeneid (one book by choice). Historical approach to Latin literature from the beginnings to Apuleius; reference manuals: A. Cavarzere, A. De Vivo, P. Mastandrea, Letteratura latina. Una sintesi storica, Roma, Carocci editore, 2015 or G.B. Conte, Letteratura latina, Firenze, Le Monnier Università, 2012. Monographic course: 'Examples of epic Latin poetry'. Reading, translation and commentary of the texts discussed during the lectures.
