Prerequisites	The course is aimed at first-year students. Attendance requires the ability to read texts in their original language.
Learning outcomes	<p>The course will focus on some aspects of Greek prose between VI and IV century B.C.</p> <p>Comments and analyses of the texts will shed light onto the history of the Greek thought in historiography, philosophy, and politics.</p>
Course contents	<p>The course is divided into three parts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) Herodotus, <i>Historiae</i> Vb) Hippocrates, <i>On Ancient Medicine</i>c) Plato, <i>Seventh Letter</i> <p>In order to prepare the final exam, students have to attend the tutoring</p>

classes, which consist in written exercises concerning texts by the authors studied in the monographic course.

For the final exam, which is oral, students have to be able to read the texts mentioned above in their original language, being well acquainted with the Greek Literature from its origin up to the IV century BC (included), in particular with the literature in prose.
