Prerequisites	Specialized Course: The course is aimed at third year students, but students of LM can attend it also.
	The requirements are the ability to read and understand the two texts in translation for students with non-philological curricula; the knowledge of the general and historical backgrounds of the Ellenistic and Imperial literature in Greek language
Learning outcomes	Through the analysis and the comment of the texts and of selected bibliography, two recurring and characterising features of imperial production will be made apparent: 1) the relationship with the classics between history and legend; 2) the dynamics of syncretism and hybridisation, first emphasised by J. G. Droysen.
