Can introduce him/herself and others and can ask and answer questions about personal details. Can interact in a simple way provided the other person talks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help.</p>
Course contents	About 45 kanji will be introduced. Vocabulary, grammar and sentence patterns related to different topics (free-time activities, hobbies, towns and transport, shopping, experience in the past) will be studied.
