Course contents	<p>Gramsci: the concept of ideology in the "Prison Notebooks"</p> <p>This is a seminar course with compulsory attendance. It will focus on examining one of the most renowned categories of Gramsci's thought, as related to other seminal concepts in his Notebooks.</p>
Teaching methods	Lectures and discussion of the papers submitted by the students.
