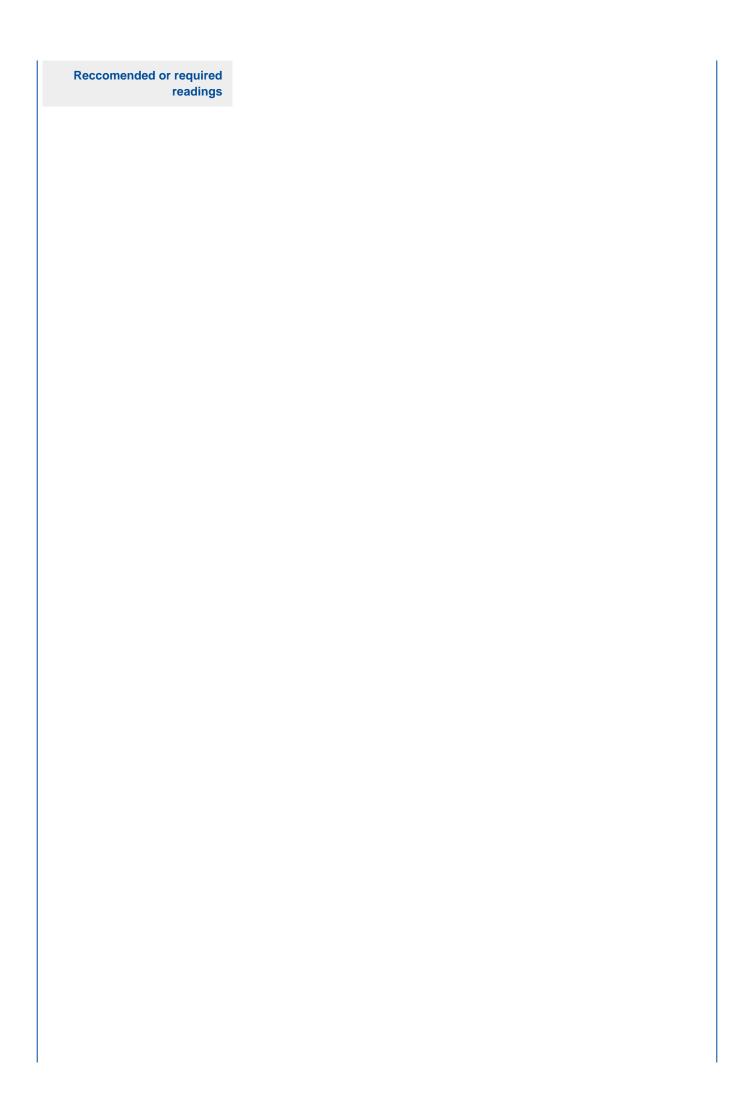


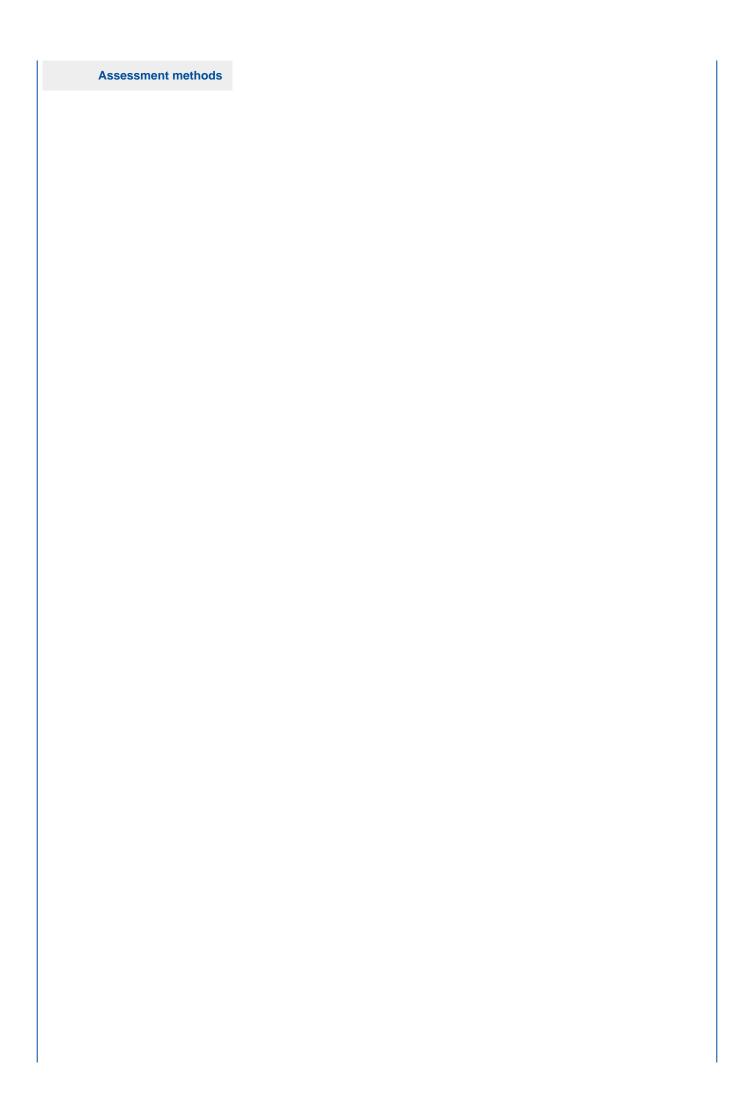

Teaching methods	Lectures


