Prerequisites	Knowledge of French Language according to the programme of the first three terms
Learning outcomes	The course aims at developing the ability of independent use of the French Language in its various skills and encourages, both orally and in writing, the necessary mastery for a correct interaction at level B1 of the European Framework of Reference.
Course contents	The course will analyze the morphological structures of the French Language, in both their formal and practice aspects, in particular the use of Pronouns. It also aim at the development of suitable strategies for the comprehension of a written text and for different types of texts. Concerning the CEL additional activity, which completes the course, you should check the general programme of FRENCH LANGUAGE and LITERATURE 2017/2018, with the information about the teaching

materials, which you must absolutely have by the beginning of the activity. **Teaching methods** Interactive and frontal lessons. Reccomended or required For students attending courses: readings Material prepared by the professor (will be available before the beginning of courses at the CLU bookshop) For students not attending courses: Material prepared by the professor (it will be available at the beginning of courses at the CLU bookshop) For all students: Marisa Ferretti, Anna Galliano, "Savoir faire, savoir apprendre, grammatica contrastiva con percorsi di autovalutazione", Petrini editore, 2003 **Assessment methods** The final exam consists in both a written text (a written comprehension questionnaire (level B1) of a journalistic text, without dictionary, and grammar exercises on the model of those done during the course and present in the professor's lecture notes. The marking system, based on the evaluation in 1/20, will assess 10 marks for the answers to the questionnaire and 10 marks for the 6/7 exercises on French morphology) and oral test (discussion about the written test and questions concerning the monographic course or, for students not attending the course, about the texts suggested). **Further information** Students will be provided with a 117 hour tutoring service; these tutoring hours will be distributed during the academic year. Tutoring will provide academic support and will integrate with the work done at the CEL courses and at the professor's course through small group meetings and, if necessary, individual meetings.

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
