It will provide the opportunity to analyse papyrus documents useful for the study of ancient Greek and roman History. Students will acquire the skills necessary to read ancient documents, and interpret papyrological editions and publications.

Imperial edicts and letters. 9. Edicts of the prefects of Egypt. 10. Petitions and citizenship. 11. (True and false) judicial proceedings. 12. Fiscal documents. 13. Private letters. 14. "Jewish" documents. 15. "Christian" documents. Part III. Workshop at Museo Egizio, Turin. **Teaching methods** The lectures will read and comment upon existing editions of papyrus documents.
